RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Train and monitor OT/PT departmental and program staff in implementing individual programs.
- Recommend Occupational Therapy activities to interdisciplinary team members.
- Provide consultation on adaptive equipment and equipment modifications.
- Complete evaluation reports, monthly progress notes, or other paperwork as required.
- Related or similar duties as required or assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicant must be certified by the National Board for Certification of Occupational Therapists and licensed by the Mississippi State Board of Health. Have two (2) years of experience as an Occupational Therapist. Applicant must submit a copy of his/her certification and licensure. Must present a valid Driver's License from Mississippi or a contiguous state and have personal insurance in order to drive a State vehicle. Experience working with individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities preferred.
