RESPONSIBILITIES:

Assists in planning and directing a program of recreational activities. Selects necessary materials, equipment, scenery, or costumes for planned recreational activities. Assists in the in-service training of new workers and staff development as necessary. Also, assists in carrying out formal training programs and entering the data into the PPS system.

Observes and reports on the results and progress of recreational activities to include participation and reactions.

Assists in supervising volunteer workers, attendants, or helpers. Coaches, instructs and supervises games, teams, and athletic events. Assists in organizing and supervising indoor games, dances and parties. Works with special groups or individuals. Requisitions and cares for recreational equipment. Related or other duties as required or assigned.

Supervises and works on floor with direct care staff.

EXPERIENCE/EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

Graduation from a standard four-year high school or equivalent (GED or High School Equivalency Diploma), 3-5+ years of experience. AND 1 year of experience related to the above described duties. Related education and related experience may be substituted on an equal basis. Must have a MS Driver license, or a license from a contiguous state. Must be eligible to drive State of Mississippi vehicles.
